DAY NINE

Battle of “discipline” – The goal of eliminating barriers of comfort, breaking out into new territory – Conquering.

Heb 12:11 *When we are punished, it seems to us at the time something to make us sad, not glad. Later, however, those who have been disciplined by such punishment reap the peaceful reward of a righteous life.*

Pro 12:1 *Any who love knowledge want to be told when they are wrong. It is stupid to hate being corrected.*

1Co 9:27 *I harden my body with blows and bring it under complete control, to keep myself from being disqualified after having called others to the contest.*

Heb 12:5 *Have you forgotten the encouraging words which God speaks to you as his children? "My child, pay attention when the Lord corrects you, and do not be discouraged when he rebukes you. :6 Because the Lord corrects everyone he loves, and punishes everyone he accepts as a child."*

Tit 1:8 *He must be hospitable and love what is good. He must be self-controlled, upright, holy, and disciplined.*

Eph 6:4 *Parents, do not treat your children in such a way as to make them angry. Instead, raise them with Christian discipline and instruction.*

1Ti 4:7 *But keep away from those godless legends, which are not worth telling. Keep yourself in training for a godly life.*

Php 3:12 *I do not claim that I have already succeeded or have already become perfect. I keep striving to win the prize for which Christ Jesus has already won me to himself. :13 Of course, my friends, I really do not think that I have already won it; the one thing I do, however, is to forget what is behind me and do my best to reach what is ahead. :14 So I run straight toward the goal in order to win the prize, which is God's call through Christ Jesus to the life above.*
