Eph 4:1 *I urge you, then--I who am a prisoner because I serve the Lord: live a life that measures up to the standard God set when he called you. :2 Be always humble, gentle, and patient. Show your love by being tolerant with one another. :3 Do your best to preserve the unity which the Spirit gives by means of the peace that binds you together. :4 There is one body and one Spirit, just as there is one hope to which God has called you. :5 There is one Lord, one faith, one baptism; :6 there is one God and Father of all people, who is Lord of all, works through all, and is in all.*

Rom 12:16 *Have the same concern for everyone. Do not be proud, but accept humble duties. Do not think of yourselves as wise.*

Pro 11:2 *People who are proud will soon be disgraced. It is wiser to be modest.*

Jas 4:10 *Humble yourselves before the Lord, and he will lift you up.*

Col 3:12 *You are the people of God; he loved you and chose you for his own. So then, you must clothe yourselves with compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness, and patience.*

1Pe 5:6 *Humble yourselves, then, under God's mighty hand, so that he will lift you up in his own good time.*
